## **Ambulant rehabilitation**

#### Residential rehabilitation:

#### Offers:

- Financial and social benefits (e.g. regarding medical costs, resources,...)
- Referral to other social services



#### **Emotional support and assistance with:**

- Talking about what happened
- The coping process

You can choose an independent psychologist or a group practice.



#### Offers support which:

- Is oriented towards repairing, as far as possible, the harm caused by the road traffic crash
- Expects active participation by the victim, the offender and possible other parties



#### European organisation which:

- Focuses on the application of restorative justice to criminal matters
- Works on development and establishment of victim-offender mediation and other restorative justice practices
